TRANSMISSION LINE PERMIT

We, E. C. Burton and wife Annie M. Burton,

for and in consideration of the sum of One and no/100Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant, to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described land situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Southeast quarter Sec. 14 Tp 22 S R 2 W

It is understood and agreed that in case the company can not get a right of way across the Maske land as now surveyed, the grantors agree that said line may be relocated across the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter Sec 14 Tp 22 S R 2 W to tie in with Calera-Columbiana Transmission Line. It is further agreed that the Company will extend service to the residence now occupied by the grantors with service charges based on our regular rural rates.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
