

Transmission line permit Sara Crim extension off of Calera

We, C H Peal and wife Sadie Peal for and in consideration of the sum of Ten and no/100----dollars, (\$10.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described land situated in Shelby & Chilton Counties, Alabama:

Block 37 of South Calera Subdivision and located in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 11 NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 14 Tp 24 N R 13 E

It is understood that this line is to be located not more than 15 feet north of fence which now marks South boundary of above said land.

It is further understood that the Company will pay all reasonable damages to crops or fences done during construction or maintenance of said line.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees that may injure or endanger said lines.

To have and to hold the said to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
