All that part of the northwest quarter of Section 33, Township 19, Range 2 East, that lies north of the Morgan road, and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Morgan Mill Road, on the east side of the Tan Yard Branch, - the point of beginning being the point of intersection of the north line of said road with the east side of said Tan Yard Branch, - thence north 28½ degrees west 10 chains, thence west 4 degrees south 1½ chains, thence north 28½ degrees west 15 chains, to H.W. Phillips land, thence west 2½ degrees south, 7½ chains to a stake, thence south 4 degrees east 28 chains to Morgan road, thence East along said road to point of beginning, being 35.2 acres. the land conveyed is intended to be the Gorman tract at Harpersville, Alabama, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

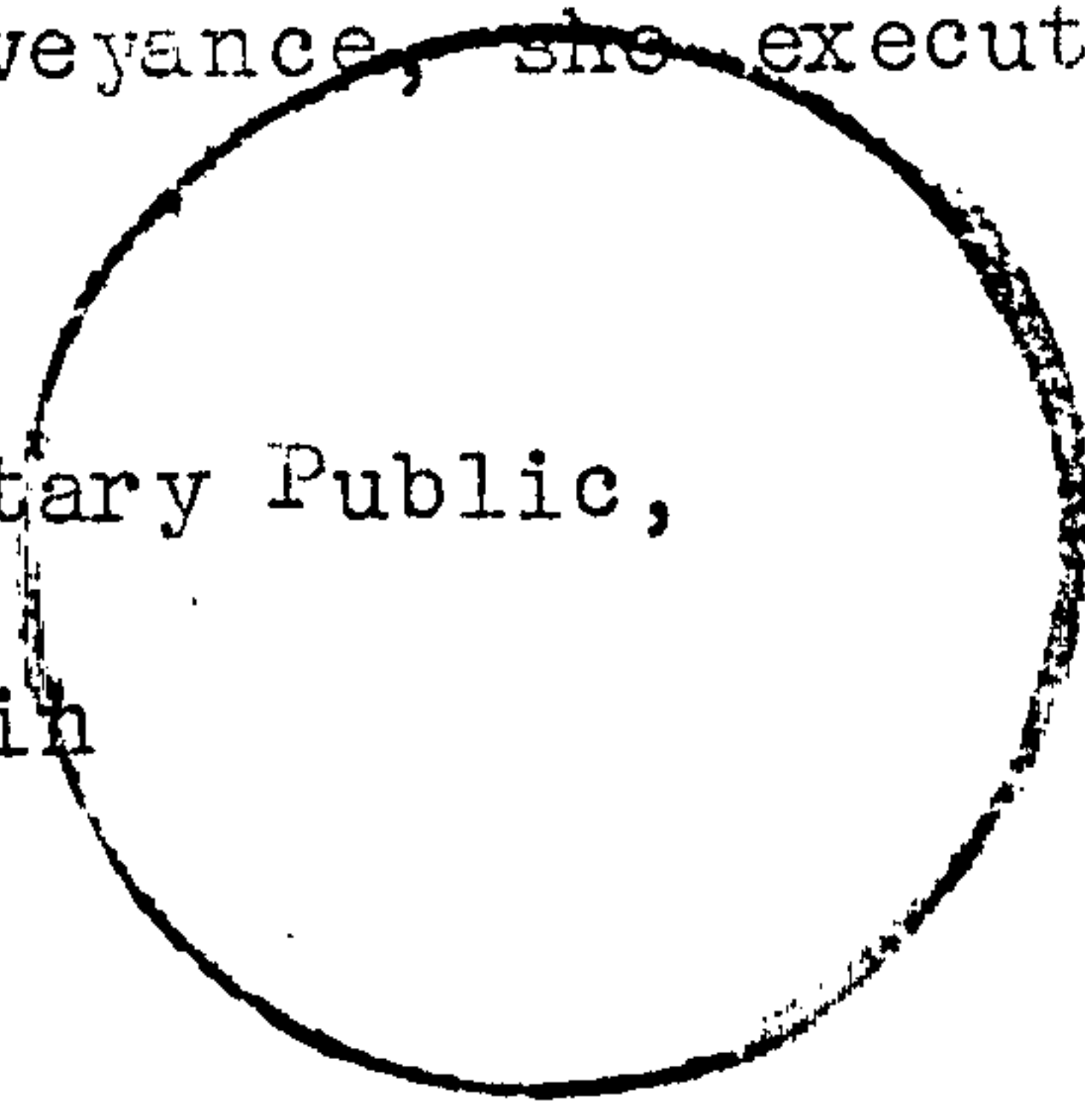
