Know all Men by these Presents, That for and in consideration of The Uses & Purposes hereinafter mentioned and DOLLARS, to the undersigned Grantors, Isaac W. Johnson & his wife M.A.R. Johnson, the sum of One dollar in hand paid by M.R.K. Johnson, W.N. Gilbert & J.M. Allen as Trustees, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the said give, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W.R.K. Johnson, W.N. Gilbert & J.M. Allen as Trustees, for the following use & purposes.

All that part of Section 22 Township 19 Range 2 West situate in said County described as follows. Commencing wherethe public road leading from Montevallo to Ashville crosses the Creek in said Section, thence in a northeasterly direction along & with said road to a cross fence North & West of said road, thence in a Northerly and westerly direction along & with said cross fence to the lane, thence in a Southwesterly direction along & with said lane to said public road, thence along said public road to the beginning point. Containing twenty acres more or less, for the purpose of the erection of a Cumberland Presbyterian Church and School house to be used & occupied for Divine Worship and the Education of the white children of the neighborhood, and also to be occupied & used by the Farmers Alliance for holding the meetings of said Farmers Alliance. Upon Condition that if the Cumberland Presbyterian Church shall abandon said land & Church building & cease to occupy and use the same for Divine Worship then and in that event the title hereby conveyed shall hereby revert to the Grantors, except three acres in the southwest portion of said tract of land; which said three acres shall be held by said trustees to be occupied and used for the education of said white children.

Allen, as such trustees, and their successors as such trustees, we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, and that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said W.R.K. Johnson, W.N. Gilbert & J.M. Allen, as such Trustees & their successors as such trustees, heirs, executors and administrators, forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.
