Oden, who, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is acquainted with the east half of the northwest quarter, the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter and the north east quarter of the southwest quarter of section 29, township 18, range 1 west, situated in Shelby County, being the lands conveyed by Vida Lumber Company to Mrs. Etta Kolodner by deed dated December 4, 1929; that he has known said lands for 15 years; that the Vida Lumber Company acquired the same from C.H. Grayson and wife in 1923; that immediately upon such acquisition Vida Lumber Company went into possession of said land and continued in possession thereof until Vida Lumber Company conveyed it to Mrs. Kolodner in 1929; that in 1923 a sawmill was erected on said land and the timber cut therefrom; that during its possession the Vida Lumber Company assessed and paid taxes thereon; that from the time of the acquisition by Vida Lumber Company to the conveyance thereof to Mrs. Kolodner, the Vida Lumber Company was in possession of said land and exercised complete control thereof by preventing others from cutting the timber and trespassing thereon; that possession of said company of said land was open, notorious, adverse under claim of ownership and continues from the time of its acquisition to the sale and conveyance thereof to Mrs. Kolodner and that the title was recognised as being in the Vida Lumber Company and that the title of the said Vida Lumber Company to said land was not questioned or disputed to the knowledge of affiant during such time.
