Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared B E Oldham, who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says that he resides at Calera, Alabama, and is an applicant for a loan from the Home Owners' Loan Corporation on the hereafter described tract of land, to-wit: That certain tract of land described in that certain mortgage executed by B.E.Oldham and wife, to Southern Building and Loan Association, dated May 24, 1929, and recorded in Mortgage Book 158, on page 229, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further says that he has examined the platt attached to the abstract on the above described lot and marked "Exhibit A", showing the above lot and adjoining tract of land; that in the deed described in Deed Book 75, on page 272, affiant bought and obtained possession of Lot 1, designated on said platt and the corners of which are designated by "X", as shown on page 57 of the abstract; that in that certain deed from B. E.Oldham to H. L. Crim, dated December 16, 1927, affiant conveyed all of Lot 1, except Lot 1a, as designated on said Exhibit A; that in the conveyance from H. L. Crim to J. H. Busby, dated January 25, 1928, recorded in Deed Book 75, on page 614, and in the conveyance from J. H. Busby to H. L. Crim, dated February 15, 1929, as shown of record in Deed Book 84, on page 187, and in the conveyance from H. L. Crim to B. E. Oldham, dated June 19, 1929, as recorded in Deed Book 84, page 188, all in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, that part of said tract of land designated on said map as Lot 1-b was conveyed and occupied by the several grantors and grantees, respectively therein; that Lot 1-b, is now owned by the said B. E. Oldham but is not included in the lands listed in said application.

Affiant further says that there is no dispute or confusion as to the boundaries between the several lots described in said tract of land designated as Tract No. 584 according to G. B. Pickett's survey for the Calera Land Company, nor in that part between the new and old Highways in said Tract.
