I am the grantee in the deed of conveyance executed by J G. Hardy and wife; bearing date of the 3rd of November, 1927, and recorded in Deed Book 79 at Page 626, Records of Deeds in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama; said deed being to the NW of the NW of Section 7, and 45 acre tract of land adjoining said lands on the east and also the West 216 feet of the SW of the SW of said Section 7, all in Township 18, Range 1, East, said deed being also to the SE of Section 12, Township 18, Range, 1, West, all in Shelby County, Alabama.

At the time said property was conveyed to me, tenants of the grantors were living in a residence on the 45 acre tract described in said deed. Said tenants immediately attorned to me and tenants of mine have been living in said residence in actual possession of said property continuously ever since said deed was made to me. In the following spring after said property was conveyed to me, I had the entire North half of the NW of said Section 7 fenced for pasture and said fence has been kept up and mainteined and said lands used for a pasture continuously ever since to the present date.

The said NW2 of the NW4 of Section 7 showed at the time I bought it that several years prior thereto, the original or virgin timber had been cut from said lands. The old stumps are still on said land and it is my information that J. L. Tinney cut the original or virgin tinber off of said lands for lumber purposes. It was also very apparent, at the time I bought the property, that timber for farm purposes had been cut from said 80 acre tract.

The residence, which I spoke of above, appeared to be something like twenty years old or older at the time I bought the property; and adjoining said residence, there was in cultivation at least 30 acres of land and the land indicated or shaowed that it had been cultivated for many years prior thereto and this land has been cultivated each year since I bought the property by tenants of mine.
