 Application 20448- WHEREAS there has been deposited in the General Land Office, of the
 United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery Alabama

Whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 30th May 1862 "To
 secure homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain" and the acts supplemental thereto
 the claim of Moses Davis has been established and duly consummated in conformity with law,
 for the

North West quarter of the South East quarter, the South half of the Northeast
 quarter and the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 2, in township 21,
 South, of Range Two West of Huntsville Meridian, in Alabama, containing one hundred and sixty
 acres, and twelve hundredths of an acre,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General
 Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Moses
 Davis, the tract of land above described to have and to hold
 the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

Moses Davis and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I, Grover Cleveland, President of the United States of America,
 have caused these letters to be made, patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to
 be hereunto affixed.
