Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said State and County, as aforesaid, personally appeared Paul O. Luck, who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that he resides in Columbiana, Alabama; that he was formerly manager of the Shelby County Abstract Company of Columbiana, Alabama; that on June 3rd, 1930, he prepared an abstract on the following described land, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, except 5 acres in the Southeast corner thereof; also the North 24 acres of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter; also 3 acres off of the West end of the South Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, said 3 acres being that part of said 40 lying West of Vincent Public Road; also in Section 20, Township 19, Range 2 East.

Affiant further says that the deed abstracted on page 3 of said abstract wherein James W. Jennings was grantor and Isaac Jones grantee, dated November 29th, 1844, was abstracted from the original deed, the same has never been placed on record and that the said sheet as shown in said abstract contains a true and correct abstract of said deed, and the endorsements thereon, which said deed conveyed the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 20, Township 19, Range 2 East, and which was later endorsed as having been transferred from J. S. Jones to A. M. Jones.

Affiant further says that the deed abstracted on page 7 of said abstract was abstracted from the original deed, the same having never been recorded, wherein W. N. Jones was grantor and James S. Jones grantee, which was dated January 6th, 1882, and which according to the endorsements thereon was transferred from J. S. Jones to A. M. Jones November 27, 1886, and which conveyed all that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of Section 20, Township 19, Range 2 East that lies North of a line running from a well on the East side of Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter running due West 660 yardse to a line dividing the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, North and South; affiant further says that the abstract sheet, shown on said page 7, is a true and correct abstract of

the original deed, which was in the possession of affiant at the time that said abstract sheet was prepared.

Affiant further says that said deeds heretofore described, together with the abstract was delivered to J. H. Jones or his attorney after the completion of said abstract.
