Sommerville, Jr., and Stuart B. Sommerville, hereinafter referred to as parties of the second part; and

whereas, said will was thereafter on the 4th day of February, 1936, duly probated and admitted to probate and record in the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama, the court of proper jurisdiction in such matters; and

WHEREAS, Thereafter, J.P.Kelly was duly appointed and qualified as administrator of said estate; and

WHEREAS, Thereafter the parties of the second part filed in the District Court of the United States for the Southern Division of the Northern District of Alabama, at Birmingham, Alabama, their suit in equity contesting said will, to which suit the party of the first part was made a party; and

WHEREAS, Upon said case coming on for trial a settlement was made between the parties thereto in accordance with an agreement of settlement which was filed in said court, and is by reference hereby referred to and made fully a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, Thereafter, there was held on the 30th day of November, 1936, a congregational meeting of said Church called and held strictly in accordance with the form of government as provided for the Presbyterian Churches in the United States, said meeting having been called by the unanimous vote of the session of said Church for the express purpose of considering said settlement above referred to, and public notice having been given of said meeting in accordance with the call of the session by posting written notices thereof in the Church, and by reading the call at an assembled meeting of the congragation, which was attended by more than one@fourth of the resident communing members, said Church not having more than 100 members; and

WHEREAS, There was adopted at such congragational meeting by the unanimous vote of a quorum thereof, a resolution approving and ratifying said settlement, and authorizing and directing A. J. Cox, the Moderator of said meeting, and F. W. Rogan, the Secretary thereof to carry out and execute the same in accordance with all its terms, a copy of which resolution so adopted is hereto attached marked Exhibit "A", with full reference thereto as if the same were fully set out;

Now, Therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of the sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) in hand by the parties of the second part to the party of the first part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Montevallo Presbyterian Church, acting by and through the undersigned as its duly authorized agents and representatives, and the undersigned as such duly authorized agents and representatives, do hereby bargain, grant, sell and convey unto the parties of the second part all right, title, interest, claim and demand of any kind or character which said church and/or its officers, and/or its members have in and to the assets of the estate of the said Selina B. Sommerville; and authorize and direct, in consideration of the receipt of said \$6,000 the said J.P.Kelly, as Administrator of said estate, to distribute and deliver the assets of said estate to the parties of the second part, or their fully authorized attorney and agent, hereby acknowledging receipt from said Administrator of any and all funds, or

property, or interest therein of said estate; and hereby releasing and discharging the said Kelly, as Administrator,

and/or the sureties on his bond from any further claim or liability of any kind on account of said will or said estate, or the administration thereof.
