- (2) That the said Elizabeth Roy file in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, and in any other county in which she seeks to do business or shall reside, before becoming 21 years of age, a certified copy of this decree;
- (3) IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the petitioner pay all costs of these proceedings, for which let execution issue.
