Woolley, who is known to me and who, being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says, that he is a bona fide resident of Shelby County, Alabama, and as such resident is entitled to a homestead exempt to him from execution, levy and/or sale, and he does own a homestead in Shelby County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows:
