A strip of land 50 feet wide lying east of and parallel to the center line of Federal Aid Project #99 as now staked out by the State Highway Department of Alabama; beginning at station 349/05 and endings at station 367/00; also a strip of land 50 feet wide lying west of and parallel with the center line and beginning at Station 349/45 and ending at station 355/50; also a strip of land 31½ feet lying west of and parallel to the center line, beginning at Station 355/50 and ending at station 358/00; also, a strip of land 50 feet wide beginning at station 358/00 and ending at station 367/00; lying on the west side and parallel to the center line of Federal Aid Project #99 lying in SE4, of NW4 of Section 33, Township 21, South, Range 2 west, situated in Shelby County, Alabama; and for and in consideration of the benefit to our property by reason of the construction of said road, we hereby release, the County

It is understood and agreed that the State Highway Department of Alabama is to take down and remove the present brick wall in front of the dwelling house of granters herein and move it back just off the edge of the right of way herein conveyed and rebuild it in front of the house, which wall is to be of the length of 182 feet, that is to say it is to be 152.5 feet on the west side of said highway and the glanges are to be 15 feet long at each end, and the wall is to be constructed of new brick.
