Know all Men by these Presents, That for and in consideration of Twenty five dollars-----DOLLARS, to the undersigned Grantor Burr Harris and wife Ethel Harris, in hand paid by C.H.Chism, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said Burr Harris and wife Ethel Harris, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said C.H.Chism, the following described Real Estate, to-wit:

Beginning at a point one hundred thirty feet (130) west of the North and south line of the northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, Section Three (3), Township twenty two (22) South, Range Four (4) west, and running in a west direction two hundred and ten (210) feet, thence in a southern direction six hundred and forty (640) feet, thence in an eastward direction two hundred and ten (210) feet, thence in a northern direction six hundred and forty feet (640) feet, to point of beginning, said lot containing four acres more or less and lying south of the Montevallo and Tuscaloosa Public road.
