Logan, for and in consideration of the sum of Two dollars and twenty five cents (\$2.25) per thousand feet lumber scale for pine, and two dollars and twenty five cents (\$2.25) per thousand board feet either log or lumber scale for hardwood, which said H. A. Belcher agrees to pay to mrs. Lilty P. Logan, The payments are to be paid on the 1st and 45th of each month, paying only for the lumber manufactured and checked previous of the time the payments are paid. We, Mrs Lilty P. Logan and husband J.P.Logan, do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said H. A. Belcher, the following described timber to wit:

All the pine timber 10 inches and over in diameter 12 inches above the ground all hardwood 12 inches and over in deameter 12 inches above the ground all of which must be merchantable, on the following described lands, to-wit: All timber in view of the L.P.Logan's present residence is excepted. SW½ of the SW½ section 5, Township 24, Range 12 east except the part lying east of Shoal Creek, E½ of the SE½ of the SE½ on section 6, Township 24, Range 12 east; N½ of the NE½, SW½ of the NE½, N½ of the SE½ and the SE½ of the NE½ all in section 7, Town ship 2½, Range 12 East; and the SW½ of the NW½ in section 8, Township 24, Range 12 east, situated, lying, and being in the county of Shelby, and State of Alabama. Together with the right of ingress and egress to, from and over said lands, and the right to build, construct and erect log roads and road ways and mill and lumber yards, necessary in cutting, logging, hauling, sawing, manufacturing and shipping said timber, lumber and removing the same from the said lands during the term of this contract. All cedar is expressly reserved.

To have and to hold the same as above described for a period of eighteen months from the date of this instrument and it is understood and agreed that upon the expiration of said period of eighteen months from the date of this instrument all timber not cut and from said land and premises above described shall revert to and become the property of the then owner of said lands and all rights, titles, privileges, and property herein bargained or sold or conveyed shall cease and terminate and shall revert to, be and become the property of the then owner of said lands.

The said H. A. Belcher agrees that he will also cut and remove all of said timber and logs and lumber above described and conveyed from the lands above described and that he will do so within the period of this contract, which said agreement is a part of the consideration of this conveyance.

It is understood and agreed that only the timber and rights and privileges above described or conveyed by this instrument, and that only for the period of time above stated in this in-

strument.
