Vaughan, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the said J. A. Brown and Annie Jo Brown, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Harriett S. Vaughan,

the following described Real Estate, to-wit:

A certain lot or parcel of land in the Town of Monte vallo, Alabama, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the north west side of Highland Street, if said street were projected to the Montevallo and Ashville road, and which point of beginning is to be two hundred feet north east of the north east line of Moody Street, measuring along the north west side of Highland Street, as projected, according to Lyman's Addition to the Town of Montevallo, Alabama, and run thence north east along the north west line of said Highland Street, as projected, a distance of 75 feet, thence north west and perpendicular from said Highland Street a distance of 150 feet, thence south west and parallel to said Highland Street, to within two hundred feet of the north east line of Moody Street, thence south east and perpendicular to Highland Street 150 feet to the point of beginning,

situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
