The payment of above indebtedness shall be made as follows; when each car logs is shipped to buyer's mill and payment made to seller \$2.00 per M on all logs shall be deducted from said payment and applied on above indebtedness and these deductions shall continue until any balance due buyer has been paid in full at which time the above mentioned truck and trailer become the propertly of seller but until full payment is paid the title to said truck and trailer shall remain in buyer.
