We, George Huddleston and wife Bertha Huddleston for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by the Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described land situated in Shelby County, Alabama:
