KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WHEREAS, on loth day of Lay A. D. 1937, the Probate Court of Shelby County rendered a decree for the sale of lands hereinafter described and conveyed, for the payment of State and County taxes then due from Harriet Hall the owner of said lands, and for the payment of the fees, costs, and expenses of and under said decree, and the sale had in execution thereof.

Now Therefore, The State Land Commissioner of the State of Labama, by virtue of and in accordance with the authority in him vested by law, with the approval of the Covernor of Labama, and in consideration of the premises above set out, has this day granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said C.O. Chambless without warranty or covenant of any kind on the part of the tate, express or implied, all right and title of the State of Alabama in and to said lands, described as follows:
