
State of Alabama, Shelby County

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned Sallie McCall, a widow, Olin McCall and wife, Mary McCall, Otis McCall and wife, May McCall, Ocie McCall an unmarried man, and Vera McCall Wyatt and husband, Adam Wyatt, in and for the consideration of one hundred and fifty dollars, in Hand paid by Shelby County, a body corporate, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the further consideration of the benefit accruing to us and to the public from the construction or improvement of a public road through our lands, in Shelby County, Alabama, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelby County, a body corporate, its successors and assigns, that a right of way hereinafter described over and across our lands in Shelby County, Alabama, for a public road, which right of way shall be of varying feet in width on each side of the center line of said road, as it is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department, or as much of our lands as is required to make a varying foot right of way across our lands, said right of way herein conveyed being more particularly described as follows; to-wit:

A strip of land 120 feet wide, lying 60 feet oneach side of the center line of highway known as FAP-248-C as now located and staked out by the State Highway Department, beginning at Station 318/42 and running along said center line a distance of 2928 feet to Station 347/70, the end of said strip of land. Also, a parcel of land described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west ROW line of said highway at 90 degrees opposite Station 333/00. Continue in a northerly direction along said ROW line for 450 feet, thence furn 170 degrees to the left and continue southerly 460 feet to the east ROW line of County road, thence turn 100 degrees to the left and continue 70 feet to point of beginning, also, begin at a point on east ROW line of proposed highway 90 degrees opposite station 340. Turn 90 degrees from said ROW line and continue easterly 70 feet to west ROW of county road. Thence southerly along said ROW l85 feet to east ROW line of proposed highway. Thence northerly along said ROW line 170 feet to point of beginning. All of the herein land lying and being in the NE2 of SW2; SE2 of NW2; SW2 of NW2 and NW2 of NW2, Section 34, Township 19 South Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama, and containing 8.6033 acres, more or less, part of which is present traveled way,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD by Shelby County, a body corporate, or its assigns, and for and in consideration of the benefit to our property by reason of the construction or improvement of said road, we hereby release the County aforesaid and all of its employees and officers, and the State of Alabama, and all of its employees and officers from all consequential damages, present or prospective, to our property, arising out of the construction, improvement, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
