To all to whome these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery, Alabama has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the claimant Walter M. Aldridge according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of April 24, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the east half of the northeast quarter of Section four in Township twenty-one south of Range one west of the Huntsville Meridian, Alabama, containing eighty acres and one hundredth of an acre, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the Tract above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, the appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever.
