Goodson his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns, the following described parcel or tract of land-viz:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SEqr- West Half of the SE Qr. and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW Qr Section 32-Township 20-Range 2 West. Containing 160 acres more or less subject to sale at the Tuscaloosa Land Office
