

Decree Relieving Minors of Disabilities of Nonage

The State of Alabama, Shelby County - Circuit Court of Shelby County, Equity Division.
IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF F. C. Oates, Sr., for the removal of the disabilities
of non age of Margaret Oates, a minor.

This cause coming on to be heard in term time ---having been submitted for Decree
on the Petition and ex-parte affidavits of William Allen Oates thereupon, upon considera-
tion thereof, it is ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that Margaret Oates a
Minor, who is over the age of Eighteen years, be, and he is Relieved of the Disabilities
of Nonage, and he is vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted
with, to received and take possession of any real and personal property to which he is
entitled; to purchase Real or Personal Estate, to sell and to convey, and to do all
things, and to all intents and purposes as effectually as if he were twenty-one years of
age.

It is further decreed that the said Margaret Oates pay the costs of this proceeding,
for which Execution may issue.
