

## Power of Attorney

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, M. L. Lester, an unmarried woman of said County in said State hereby constitute and appoint Roy B. Lester of Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, as my attorney with full power of substitution for me and in my name to satisfy on the records in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, the following described mortgages: that certain mortgage executed by H. L. Gould and wife, Rosa Gould, to me on January 31, 1921, and recorded in said office in Mortgage Book 129, Page 153, and that certain mortgage executed by G. B. Wheeler, an unmarried man to me on August 15, 1925, and recorded in said office in Mortgage Book 141, Page 130, hereby ratifying and confirming the acts of my said attorney in the premises, but without further or additional authority.

I further certify that I am a daughter of Sarah L. Lester, and that she and Samuel R. Lester were the sole owners and operators of Lester & Company, a partnership, on October 11, 1899, and that no other person became a partner or part owner of said business between October 11, 1899 and August 22, 1905, except the heirs of said Sarah L. Lester, who succeeded her upon her death.
