Before J. REESE MURRAY, Referee in Bankruptcy:

On November 5, 1938, an Order was made that the Report of Trustee setting aside exemptions to the Bankrupt lie over for 10 days for the filing of objections or exeaptions and 10 days having elapsed and no objections or exceptions having been filed by any person or party in interest, it is now by the Court

CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the said Report of the Trustee setting aside exemptions for the Bankrupt filed in this proceeding on November 5, 1938, is approved and confirmed and there is now set aside to the Bankrupt, Edna L. Messer, as her exemptions the following:

A lot in the town of Columbiana, Alabama, commencing at a point on the North margin of Mildred or White House Street, and on the Eastern line of the Alley running along the west line of Section 25, Township 21, Range 1 West, and at the intersection of the said boundary lines, and running thence in an Easterly direction along the North boundary line of said Mildred or White House Street, a distance of 180 feet to a point which is the Southwest corner of the lot now occupied by L. D. Cole, for the point of beginning, and running thence in a Northwesterly direction and parallel with the lot heretofore known as the Mrs. Sue Bird lot, a distance of 163 feet, more or less, to a fence, thence in a Southwesterly direction along said fence 72 feet more or less, to the Northeast Corner of what was formerly known as the Christian lot; Thence in a Southerly direction and parallel with the first named line 160 feet, more or less, to the Northern line of said Mildred or White House Street, to a point which is the South East corner of said Christian lot, thence running in a Northeasterly direction along the North boundary of said Mildred or White House Street, a distance of 72 feet, more or less, to the point of Beginning, containing the buildings and improvements thereon and upon which there is situated a rock dwelling, in which Edna L. Messer now resides and which petitioner occupies as a homestead, as aforesaid, and which she estimates to be worth or the value of \$1,350.00.

The Trustee also sets aside as exempt, the following:

Kitchen furniture, household furniture, wearing apparel, etc., in said homestead located and used by her in connection with her use and occupancy of said homestead.
