do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said Frances Peter,

the following described property—to wit:

North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$); Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$); Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$); Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$); Section 29, Township 21, South of Range 3 West; reserving and excepting, however, all timber located on said land which is six inches and over in diameter twelve inches from the ground, together with the right to enter upon said land and remove said timber at any time within twelve years from the date hereof, with all necessary rights of ingress and egress to and from said land for the purpose of removing said timber.
