Horsley, of the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, its true and lawful attorney, for it and in its name and behalf to mark satisfied and to cancel of record that certain conditional sales contract in the amount of \$2,231.00 executed by the Montevallo Coal Mining Company on the 7th day of May, 1935, and by which Alabama Power Company retained title to the equipment sold thereunder, said conditional sales contract being recorded in Mortgage Book M-167, at page 383 in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama, the indebtedness, as secured for which title was reserved in said contract, now having been paid in full.
