It is understood that thees are not to be cut down and removed but trees may be trimmed for the necessary clearance of lines of said Alabama Power Company.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines and also the right to cut and keen clear all trees and to keen clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.
