Batson for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars (\$1.00) to ----- in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon; over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

Tract containing 15.20 acres, more or less, described as follows: Commence at NW corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36 T 19 R 3 W; thence S along W line of said 40 acres 512.6 ft. to Southerly R/W line of old Helena-Acton railroad spur track; thence angle to left of 110 deg. 3 min.; run Northeasterly along S line of said R/W for 51 ft. to point of beginning; thence angle to right of 74 deg. 47 min; run SE 754 ft. to NW line of a 50 ft. county road; thence angle to left of 92 deg. 3 min.; run along NW line of said road to point of said road; which point is 100 ft. W of and at right angles to E line of said 40 acres; thence N along 100 ft. W of and parallel with E line of said 40 acres to S line of Helena-Acton Railroad R/W; thence SW along R/W line to beginning.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
