

Transmission Line Permit

State of Alabama,
County of Shelby.

We, W. I. Jenkins and wife Etta Jenkins for and in consideration of the sum of One and no/100-- Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection of therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

A part of the SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄ of Section 22, Township 20, Range 3 West, described as follows:
Begin on the West side of a certain road at the Northeast corner of R. S. Cook's land and run west along the North boundary of said R. S. Cook's land 424 feet; thence North 100 feet to corner of "Stobart" Lot, formerly known as the Charlie Riddle Lot; thence east 424 feet to the West boundary of above mentioned road; thence south along the West boundary of said road to the point of beginning, containing one acre, more or less, and being bounded as follows: North by land of Carrie Cummins, east by dirt road, south by R. S. Cook's land, and west by land of R. S. Cook.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear ogher obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
