Now Therefore, the said Central Hanover Bank and Trust Company, Trustee as aforesaid, has released and quitclaimed and by theme presents does release and forever quitclaim, unto the said South rn Railway Company, its successors and assigns, all and every interest, right, title and demand which the said Union Trust Company of New York, and its successors in trust namely, Central Union Trust Company, may have acquired or may now
