Warranty Deed

TENNESSEE COAL, IRON AND RAILROAD COMPANY to TENNESSEE LAND COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that, for the consideration of Two Thousand, Seven Hundred Dollars (\$2,700.00) paid to the Tennessee Coal, Ironand Railroad Company, a corporation, by the Tennessee Land Company, a corporation, receipt whereof is acknowledged, the said TENNESSEE COAL, IRON AND RAILROAD COMPANY does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said TENNESSEE LAND COMPANY the following described land and interests in land located in Township 19 South, Range 2 West of the Huntsville Principal Meridian, Shelby County, Alabama:

- (1) The South-West quarter of South-East Quarter of Section 9;
- (2) All the coal, iron ore and other minerals in the South-west diagonal half of South-west quarter of South-West quarter of Section 10; North west diagonal half of North-West quarter of North - West quarter of Section 15; together with all mining rights and privileges owned by the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Gompany;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Tennessee Land Company, its successors and assigns, forever, SUBJECT, however to such easements as may exist over, upon or across said land for public roads, electric transmission lines; telephone lines, telegraph lines or pipe lines; including right for maintenance and use of an electric power transmission line granted by Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company to Alabama Power Company by agreement dated Navember 27, 1936.

And the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company does for itself and for its successors and assigns ovenant with the said Tennessee Land Company, its successors and assigns, that it, the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company, is lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, except as herein mentioned; that it has a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid and that it will and its successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the same to the said Tennessee Land Company, its successors and assigns, forever against the lawful claims of all persons.

And the CENTRAL HANOVER BANK AND TRUST COMPANY, formerly the Central Union Trust Company of New York (successors trustee under the mortgage or deed of trust executed by the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company in favor of the Union Trust Company of New York, Trustee, dated July 1, 1901, being such successor by merger of said Union Trust Company of New York into Central Trust Company of New York) in consideration of the payment to it by the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company of the sum of Two Thousand, Seven Hundred Dollars (\$2,700.00) receipt of which is acknowledged, does join in the execution of this conveyance for the sole purpose of releasing the property herein conveyed from the lien and operation of said mortgage or deed of trust of July 1, 1901, but the Central Hanover Bank and Trust Company joins in the execution of this conveyance as trustee aforesaid without covenants or warranties of any kind expressed or implied with respect to said land or any part thereof.
