

Release on judgment

Whereas, on the 3rd day of February, 1931, J. R. Johnson procured a judgment against H. R. Cox in the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, for the sum of One hundred and sixty six and 20/100----dollars, together with the cost in the sum of \$10.40; and,

Whereas, a certificate of said judgment was recorded in Judgment record "D" at page 23 on the 5th day of February, 1931, in the Probate office of Shelby County, Alabama; and,

Whereas, said H. R. Cox is the owner of a one fifth undivided interest in the timber on the south east quarter of the north east quarter of Section 34, Township 20 South Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama, and has agreed to sell and has executed a deed to W.P. Brown & Sons Lumber Company, a corporation, conveying to it his interest in all timber on said land measuring eight inches and over in diameter measured six inches from the ground; and,

Whereas, said deal cannot be consummated due to the lien of the recorded judgment aforesaid:

Now, Therefore, I, Ella Peebles Johnson, individually and as Executrix of the last will and testament of said J.R. Johnson, deceased, for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars, paid to me in hand by said H.R. Cox, the receipt of which is acknowledged, do hereby release, said timber above described from the operation of said judgment. Witness my hand and seal this the 18th day of May, 1939.
