

Power of attorney

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Reconstruction Finance Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of an Act of Congress entitled "Reconstruction Finance Corporation Act ", approved January 22, 1932, hereby and by these presents does made, constitute, and appoint Edward W. Long and Fred H. Foy, of the City of Birmingham, Jefferson County, State of Alabama, and each of them severally and not jointly, its true and lawful attorney for it and in its name and stead:

(1) To satisfy, discharge or release, by appropriate instrument, or in any manner authorized by statute, any contract for the sale of property, chattel mortgage, real estate mortgage or other instrument creating a lien which secures any note, bond, or other evidence of indebtedness held by Reconstruction Finance Corporation.

(2) To assign by appropriate instrument and without representation, recourse, or warranty any contract for the sale of real property, chattel mortgage, real estate mortgage, or other instrument creating a lien which secured any note, bond, or other evidence of indebtedness held by said Reconstruction Finance Corporation.

(3) To indorse and deliver notes and to assign and deliver bonds for collection.

(4) To accept beneficial interests in trust of real property.

Further giving and granting unto its said attorney Edward W. Long and Fred H. Foy, of the City of Birmingham, Jefferson County, State of Alabama, and each of them severally and not jointly, full power and authority to do and to perform all and every act and thing requisite, necessary, and proper to be done for the purpose of effecting the premises herein contained, including, but without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the execution and delivery of such documents as may be appropriate or necessary, and hereby ratifying and confirming all that its said attorneys shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
