Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Mrs. Ida Lee Jackson, who being duly sworn deposes and says that she resides at Wilsonville, Alabama; and that for a period of more than 37 years last past she has been acquainted with the following described lands,- the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 22, Township 21, Range 1 East, and the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 22, Township 21, Range 1 East.

Affiant being first duly sworn deposes and says further that she was the wife of W. J. Jackson, the grantee, now deceased, in that certain deed from J. E. Jackson and wife, S.E. Jackson to W.J. Jackson, dated January 17, 1902, and recorded in deed book 23, on page 546 in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, wherein the description of the land first given was the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of the description of record was later changed to read the the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of said Sec. 22 Tp 21 R 1 E., said Section 22, Township 21, Range 1 East, and that the said change of record was made in said deed. Affiant further says that the lands purchased, paid for, conveyed and possession taken thereof, was the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 22, Township 21, Range 1 East, and not the Northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of said section 22; that the grantee W.J. Jackson was never in possession or made any claim whatever under and by virtue of the above described deed, nor was he ever in possession or claimed any right or interest in the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, but actually bought and went into possession and was in the open, notorious, continuous, peaceful and adverse possession of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section 22, up until said lands were sold on October 21, 1913, to A.C. Nash; affiant further says that she has never heard the title of the said Madora Reinhardt or those through whom she holds title to said lands to be questioned in any way.
