

AFFIDAVIT

W. R. Little being duly sworn, deposes and says that he lives at Leeds, Alabama; that he is 78 years of age; that his father was Wilburn K. Little, who is dead; that he remembers the fact of his father's buying a farm from Merritt Ellard about the year 1883, this farm being on the Montevallo-Ashville Road in Shelby County, Alabama, which farm includes the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 16, Township 18, South, Range 1 West.

At the time hfs father purchased the place, there was a farmhouse on it and other improvements. His father went into the actual possession of this farm at the time he bought it and lived on this farm from the time he bought it until the year 1910, when he sold it to J. H. Purdy; that no one disputed his father's right to this piece of land.
