That he is the above named affiant, over the age of twenty-one years and lived in Shelby County, Alabama; that he knows and has known for more than twenty years the following described lands, to-wit:

The Northeast Quarter of the Southeast quarter, and the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty-four, Township Twenty, Range Two, West, and the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Nineteen, Township Twenty, Range One, West, containing in all One Hundred and Twenty acres, more or less, together with all improvements in any wise belonging thereto, and situated, lying and being in said Shelby County, Alabama.

That affiant is L. E.
