Walton, parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred & Sixty dollars to us in hand paid by B.A. Lester of Shelby County, State of Alabama- the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said B.A. Lester, and his heirs and assigns-forever, all our and each of our right, title interest, Estate, claim, and demand- both at law and in equity- and as well in popipion as in Expectancy of in, and to all that certain Farm or parcel of land situate in Shelby County, Ala- known as the West 1/2 of SW¹/₄- the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4-the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4- the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 Sect 11~~6~~ also the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4, the E 1/2 of NW 1/4 Sect 14; Township 20- Range 1 West- containing three hundred sixty acres more or less- with all & singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging in witness whereof we have hereunto set our seals this 25th day of October, in year 1870
