We, D. D. Wooley and wife Zuella T. Wool ly, for and in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliannes necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

Beginning at the NW corner of lot 15 Block 2 as shown on map of J. E. Bozeman, then south 260 feet, thence East 1100 feet to the Montevallo Road, thence along said road to South side of Birmingham Street, thence along the south side of said street to point of beginning containing 8 acres more or less. In the town of Wilton, Shelby County, Alabama.

The Power Company agrees to pay all damages to crops on said lands acused by it during the construction or maintenance of said lines, provided, notice of such damage is given the company within 30 days after such damage occurs, however, the grantor, their heirs or assigns shall have no lien for the payment of such amounts.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and engress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
