I, E. V. Willis, an unmarried man for and in consideration of the sum of Two and no/100 Dollars (\$2.00) to me in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

A tract of land beginning 274 S of NE corner of Section 2, Township 21, Range 3 W and running S 74½ Feet; thence N 83 degrees 30' W 759 feet to R/W of Birmingham-Montgomery highway a point 304½ feet N of a property line known as C. C. Murrah line; thence N along said highway 70½ feet; thence S 87 degrees 45' E 754.8 feet to beginning; said tract of land being in NE¼ of NE¼ of section 2 Tp 21, range 3 W.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
