A tract of land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 21, Range 3 W beginning 348 feet south of the NE corner of above section, thence $74\frac{1}{2}$ feet north; thence N 83 degrees 30° west 763 feet to 45E R/W of Birmingham-Montgomery highway, thence N along said highway R/W $70\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence S 87degrees/759 feet to point of beginning.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and engrees to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.
