That part of northeast quarter of southeast quarter east of Wilsonville-Montgomery public road also 37 acres north of Beeswax Creek in southeast quarter of southeast quarter, Section 21 Township 21 Range 1 East; also one acre east of above road and east of Beeswax Creek in southwest quarter of southeast quarter, Section 21, Township 21, Range 1 East.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or conveniet for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
