South half of southeast quarter of southeast quarter, Section 28, southwest quarter of southwest quarter of southwest quarter of southwest quarter, Section 27, Township 21, Range 1 East.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary on convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereofi, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.
