Beginning at the intersection of the center line of the said road with the property line of the said Shelby Iron Co. and Dr. J. H. Williams, thence 210 feet more or less to the intersection of the center line of the said road with the property line of the said Shelby Iron Co. and of A. M. Richard and B. M. Morris, the above described tract of land lying in the NW4 of the NE4 and the NE4 of the NW4 all in Section 26, Township 21S, Range lW, Shelby County and containing 0.24 acres more or less.

And for and in consideration of the benefits to our property by reason of the construction of said road, we hereby release the County from all consequential damages, present or prospective to our property, arising out of the construction, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
