McClinton according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the north east quarter of the north west quarter of Section eighteen in Township nineteen of range two east in the district of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama containing thirty nine acres and ninety two hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land office by the Sruveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Willis G. McClinton.

McClinton and to his heirs and assigns forever.
