I am acquainted with and own the south east quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 15, Township 19 Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama, and have known this land all of my life. This forty acres of land is in the corporate limits of the Town of Vincent, Alabama.

What is known as the Coosa Valley Road, now the Columbiana and Vincent Highway runs in a northerly and so utherly direction something over a quarter of a mile east of this forty, and there turns out from said highway a public road, known as the Carter road, which road turns out from said highway at which is known as the W.D.Raley residence, and runs in a westerly direction along the center line of Section 15, or practically along said center line, for more than half a mile and on beyond my western property line, being the western property line of the forty above described.

Just after the road leaves my property it runs on in a westerly direction for the depth of approximately two acres and then turns in a northwesterly direction, and then runs approximately half a mile until it comes into or intersects another public road leading into the Elliott settlement.

Ehis Carter Road is a public road and has been in use for over a hundred years, according to my information, and certainly for over forty years, within my recollection. This road is worked by the County and kept up by the County and is recognized as a public road and is a public road.
