KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That for value received, I, Annie T. Roberson do hereby transfer, sell and assign to John Cain as attorney in fact for Billy Bloxom Three promissory notes in the sum of Two Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$200.00) each, bearing date March 16th, 1940, the first note being payable on or before March 16th, 1941, the second note being payable on or before March 16th, 1942, and the third note being payable on or before March 16th, 1943, said notes bearing interest from date at the rate of 6% per annum and being executed by Ruby Mary McKinney and A. E. McKinney, and payable to the undersigned at the First National Bank of Birmingham; and for the same consideration, I do transfer, sell and assign said mortgage executed by Ruby Mary McKinney and husband to me, which mortgage bears date March 16th, 1940, and conveys the following described property situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:-

North half of South Half of Northeast Quarter ($N\frac{1}{2}$ of $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) Section Twenty-Two (22), and North Half of Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter ($N\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) Section Twenty-Three (23), all in Township Twenty One (21), Range Three (3) West.

And I do hereby transfer said mortgage, together with all rights and powers therein contained.

It is understood and agreed that the indebtedness secured by the remaining two notes secured by said mortgage and not herein transferred are subordinated to the indebtedness hereby secured, but upon the payment of the indebtedness hereby transferred, the said John Cain as attorney in fact for Billy Bloxom shall retransfer said mortgage to the undersigned.
