

## TRANSMISSION LINE PERMIT

STATE OF ALABAMA |

COUNTY OF JEFFERSON |

George Huddleston and wife, Mrs. Bertha Huddleston for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

The East  $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  in Sec. 17, Tp. 19, Range 1 West and 10 acres in the south part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  in Sec. 8, tp. 19, range 1 west.

Except as to 10 acres off S side of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 8 as above. all poles must be placed one foot out side of road right of way, as to which 10 acres the right of way shall be along S side of said parcel and within 15 ft. of s line of said 40.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

To have and to hold the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
