Nicholas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said S. W. Nicholas his heirs and assigns, the following described real estate, situated in the county of Shelby and State of Alabama, to-wit:

All of my interest in the south east quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the south west quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, township 20 South range 4 west containing 40 acres more or less. Also north half of the north west quarter (NW $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and south east quarter of north west quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$) section 6 township 21 South range 4 west, containing 120 acres more or less.

To have and to hold, the aforegranted premises to the said S. W. Nicholas his heirs and assigns forever. And I do covenant with the said S. W. Nicholas his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforementioned premises; that they are free from all encumbrance; that I have a good right to sell and convey the same to the said S. W. Nicholas his heirs and assigns, and that I will warrant and defend the premises to the said S. W. Nicholas his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
