We, Cecil A. Carlisle and wife Sue B. Carlisle for and in consideration of the sum of ONE HUNDRED & NO/100 - - - Dollars (\$100.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant, to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power wires --- said poles upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the West half of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, all in Section 36, Township 18, Range 2 West, and more fully described as follows:

Begin at the northeast corner of the said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ run south along the east boundary of the said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 966.7 feet to a point, which is the point of beginning; thence run south 45 degrees 31 minutes west a distance of 1326.6 feet to an angle, thence south 18 degrees 44 minutes west a distance of 827 feet to an angle point, thence south 26 degrees a distance of 187.5 feet to a point on the West boundary of the said West half of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$.

It is agreed that the said line of poles shall be cleared of all trees fifteen feet on each side of said line, and also that the trees so cut shall remain the property of the Grantors hereto; Map of the survey is hereby attached to ----- a copy of this permit.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
